Tournament Rules

ALL LEVELS

*All basketball will be confined to the courts only. Please respect our building and not have basketballs out in other areas. Coaches will be asked to help enforce this rule.

*Home team must provide

scorekeeper for game

*Teams must provide their own basketballs

*Games consist of 15 min. half with

a. running clock

*Five-minute half time

*Two minute overtime periods with clock stopping on all whistles. A second overtime will be sudden death.

*Teams are allowed 4 timeouts per game. One timeout per team per overtime.

NSAA High School Rules with the following exceptions:

*No full court press for 5th & 6th

*Full court press allowed for 7th & 8th til lead of 10 or more points.

5th & 6th adjustment to lane violation of 5 seconds and 8 second inbound violation.

Excessive and flagrant behavior by players, coaches and fans will not be tolerated. Violation will result in

immediate expulsion from the game and the gym at the discretion of the officials and Booster Club coordinators.
