

KNIGHT PRIDE 2008 TOURNAMENT AND GAME INFORMATION

Tournament Directors & Supervisors:

Aaron Meyer / Merritt Nelson - Please direct all questions and concerns to the tournament directors.

Game Rules:

1. Each game will consist of 4 six minute quarters. Clock will stop on all dead balls. If a team has at least a ten point lead, the clock will run continuously for the last 2 minutes of the game, with the exception of free throws and time-outs.
2. If the score is tied at the end of regulation, a one minute overtime period will be played. If the score remains tied after the 1st overtime, the 2nd overtime will be sudden death. Each overtime will begin with a jump ball.
3. Each team will receive 1 one minute time-out per half. Unused time-outs will NOT carry over. Each team will receive one additional time-out for the first overtime period.
4. There will be no pressing in the 4th and 5th grade games until two minutes left in each half if the game is within 10 points. Pressing will be allowed in the 6th, 7th, and 8th grade games if the score is within 10 points. Pressing consists of any defensive player not moving toward the half court line once the opposing team gains full possession of the ball.
5. Each team will be given a five minute warm-up before each game, time permitting. Each half-time will be five minutes in length. Each quarter and overtime break will be one minute in length.
6. Other rules will be enforced as the 2007-2008 NSAA basketball rule book outlines.

Concessions & Admission:

Concessions: Food, drink and all concessions will be available at the concession stands.

Admission: \$1 for children 12 years old and younger, \$2 for all others, children 5 and under admitted free.

Medals:

Each player will receive a medal. Each player on a championship team will receive a gold championship medal. Second place teams will receive a silver runner-up medal. Neck ribbons will be on sale in the kitchen for \$0.50. Please do not leave the gym after your final game until all players have received their medal. In the grade divisions that are round robin, it may be difficult at times to determine your team's placing until all games in the division have been completed. We will do our best to hand out medals after your last game, but in some cases this may not be possible. If needed, we will mail your medals, or if a team representative is still around when the final game in your division is completed we will give your teams' medals to that person.

Bookkeeper: (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

The top team in each bracket, or the 1st team listed in the round robin brackets must provide one adult to help keep book at the scorer's table for each game. The coach of the top team in each bracket is responsible for providing this adult. Coaches...please share this information with the parents of your team members so a volunteer is ready before the game is ready to start.

Referees:

All games will have two paid referees. Coaches and parents are asked to set an example by being courteous and respectful to all officials and workers. Please direct all concerns to the tournament directors. Please do NOT deal directly with the officials.
